1) Building Contractors from Category H to A

Professionals in Building of high rise office blocks and flats, warehouses, factories, housing, schools, hospitals, universities, etc.

2) Civil Engineering Contractors from Category H to A

Professionals in Construction of roads, dams, soccer fields, airports, tunnels, mining, surface paving, etc.

3) Electrical from Category H to A

These are contractors who add value to the structures

4) Suppliers and Hirers of Earthmoving Equipment

eg. Graders, Dump Trucks, Tractors, Tippers, Front End Loaders, Excavators, Water Bowsers, Vibrator Pavers, Backhoe Loaders, Concrete Mixers, Tar Sprayers, etc

5) Associate / Suppliers of Construction Materials

Manufacturers and retailers of construction materials, eg; Cement, Bricks, Quarry stones, Doors, Ceiling, Electrical Material, Paint, Tiles, Window Glasses, Granite Stones and other Building Hardware Materials.

Consistency- We will always deliver quality service consistently.

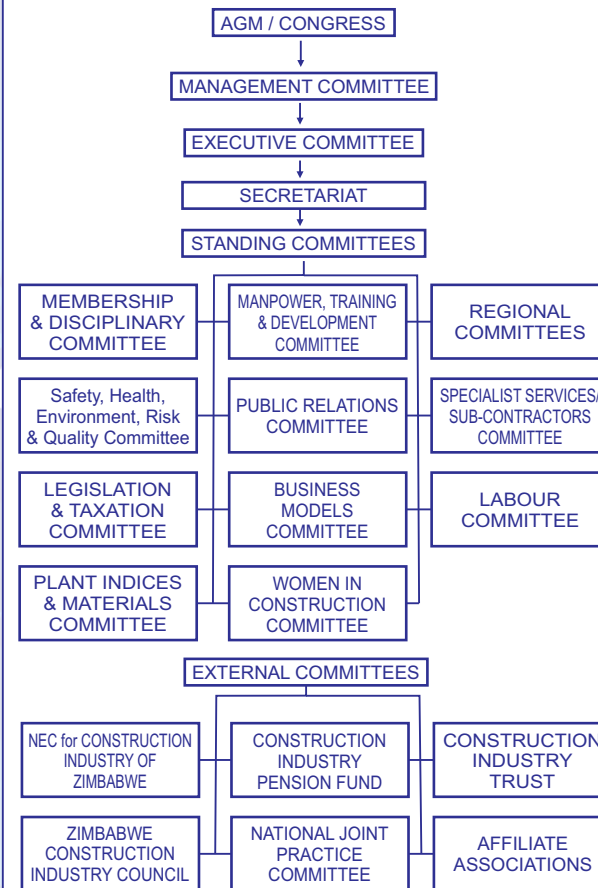
Integrity- We will strive to carry out our business in a morally sound and transparent manner befitting of a professional body
